Email confirmations will be sent to those providing a legible email address on their entry form. If you would like to receive your entry status by USPS prior to the issuance of the preliminary judging schedule at closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry.

- All entries must be original copies submitted on official AKC Agility Entry Forms (attached), one dog per entry form.
- Photocopied entries without the AKC agreement attached are **NOT** acceptable.
- Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are **NOT** acceptable and will not be entered into the trial (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 4).
- Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted.
- Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must: 1) include postage or be metered; and 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier services, including, but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL.
- Please waive signature requirements on all forms of delivery. **Mail requiring signatures will be returned to the sender.**
- A maximum of ten (10) entries per envelope are allowed. Envelopes with more than ten (10) entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.
- No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries.
- Make checks out to **Greater Lincoln Obedience Club (GLOC)**.
- A returned check charge of \$35 will be leveled.
- Move ups (prior to trials) will be accepted until **June 10, 2025** at 5 pm CT.
- Day to day move ups will be accepted and must be provided to the Trial Secretary in writing at the trial site not later than the day preceding the event.

Online Entries This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 165 runs online (50%), 165 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Privileges (PAL/ILP), and AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

- Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on soccer turf. Ring size will be 95 x 110'.

Course Walk-Throughs and Warm-Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. Only handlers entered in the class will be permitted on the course. Face coverings are mandatory for walkthroughs. Walkthroughs will be limited to 25 handlers. If multiple walkthroughs are required for a class, they will be back-to-back and there will be no 5 minute countdown clock. Face coverings are not required while running your dog.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training the dog.

Ribbons and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place – Blue	Second Place – Red
Third Place – Yellow	Fourth Place – White
Qualifying Score – Dark Green	

A new title ribbon and pin will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH or PACH rosette and decorated MACH or PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that achieve their MACH or PACH.

Notice to Exhibitors

Food

Food and bottled water will be provided for volunteers. Limited concessions may be available on site, and some fast food restaurants are within 2 miles of the trial site.

Trial Site

Trial Site will be available after 7:00 am Friday through Sunday. This trial will be held indoors on soccer turf. Bring chairs, crates, and clean up tools.

Dogs must be removed from the trial site upon completion of the trial.

Indoor crating space is available in an adjacent area to the agility ring. No ex-pens will be permitted inside the building. Crate mats &/ or tarps **MUST** be used under crates and chairs in the crating area.

No Food or beverages will be allowed on the soccer floor surface.

Safety, Behavior, and Liability

By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

The Greater Lincoln Obedience Club and AKC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or death sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s).

Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.

Exhibitors are expected to comply with the City of Lincoln's Disposal of Dog Waste Ordinance: *Any person having custody or control of any dog shall have the responsibility of disposing of dog feces or manure of the dog in a sanitary manner.*

Crates may be left overnight; however, the Greater Lincoln Obedience Club and Lincoln Sports Foundation will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

All dogs on site **MUST belong to an entered competitor.**

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries After Closing Date/Time

A wait list will be kept until Monday, June 9, 2025 to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the wait list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. IF a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled, but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the wait list close date will receive a full refund.

Directions To The Trial Site

The complex, previously named Abbott Sports Complex, is 1.3 miles north of US-6/Cornhusker Hwy on N 70th St.

From the East and Northeast: Exit I-80 at US-6 toward Waverly/E Lincoln. Turn left onto US-6 W. Keep left to stay on US-6 over overpass. Turn right at light onto N 70th St. In 1.3 miles, complex is on the right.

From the North and Northwest: Exit I-80 at Exit 405 for US-77 N/56th St. Turn right onto N 56th St. In 0.2 miles, turn left onto Arbor Rd, then in 1 mile turn right onto N 70th St. Sports complex is 0.4 miles on left. NOTE: Arbor Rd is paved but narrow with considerable heavy truck damage. Alternate route is to continue on N 56th St until road T's at US-6. Turn left onto US-6 and in 1 mile turn left on to N 70th St. In 1.3 miles, complex is on the right.

Refunds

- **Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete.** Entry fees will be refunded.
- **Refunds** (less \$6.00 administrative fee and applicable AKC Recording fees per day (\$3 per run entered)) for all other reasons will be considered on a case-by-case basis by the GLOC board. Request for refunds must be submitted via email to gloctrialdirector@gmail.com within 7 days of the last day of the trial. Include rationale and any supporting documentation. Decision will be provided after the next GLOC board meeting (typically meets the first Thursday of the month).
- **No refunds** will be given in the event a handler is disqualified or excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- If, because of riots or civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.
- GLOC reserves the right to cancel these trials after the closing date in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

Ringside

- **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their classes if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

RV Parking

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in the 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only (FEO) will be offered and allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? ____
